1. General Conditions

- 1.1. This project is for the **Proposed OBA Sewer Extension Projects within Nyeri County** as shown in the EIA report **NEMA/NYR/PR/5/2/1877**
- 1.2. The licence shall be valid for 24 months from the date of issue
- 1.3. Without prejudice to the other conditions of this license, the proponent shall implement and maintain an environmental management system, organizational structure and allocate resources that are sufficient to achieve compliance with the requirements and conditions of this license.
- 1.4. The Authority shall take appropriate action against the proponent in the event of breach of any of the conditions stated herein or any contravention to the Environmental Management and Co-ordination Act, 1999 and regulations there under.
- 1.5. This license shall not be taken as statutory defense against charges of pollution in respect of any manner of pollution not specified herein.
- 1.6. The proponent shall ensure that records on conditions of licenses/approval and project monitoring and evaluation shall be kept on the project site for inspection by NEMA's Environmental Inspectors.
- 1.7. The proponent shall submit an Environmental Audit Report in the first year of occupation/operation/commissioning to confirm the efficacy and adequacy of the Environmental Management Plan.
- 1.8. The proponent shall comply with NEMA's improvement orders throughout the project cycle

2. Construction/ Installation Conditions

- 2.1 The proponent shall ensure a traffic management plan is developed and Approved by Kenya National Highways Authority-KeNHA , Kenya Rural Roads Authority(KERRA) and Kenya Urban Road Authority (KURA) and implemented during the construction phase to ensure no interference with traffic flow on the road along the site.
- 2.2 The proponent shall put up a project signboard as per the Ministry of Works Standards indicating the NEMA license number among other information.
- 2.3 The proponent shall ensure that all excavated material and debris is collected, re used and where need be disposed off as per the Environmental Management and Coordination (Waste Management) Regulations 2006.
