WATERFUND COMMISSIONS IMPACTFUL MOYALE AND NORTH HORR INTEGRATED PROJECTS IN MARSABIT COUNTY

On 8th and 10th of April 2025, Water Sector Trust Fund (WaterFund) successfully commissioned the Moyale and North Horr Integrated Projects in Marsabit County. The commissioning ceremonies were led by H.E. Mohamud Ali, Governor of Marsabit County; Hon. Lucas Chepkitony and Mr. Barako Qatamur from the WaterFund Board of Trustees; and Ms. Nancy Njenga from the Danish International Development Agency (DANIDA).

The successful impact of the projects was made possible with funding from WaterFund with financial support from DANIDA, counterpart funding from the County Government of Marsabit with the implementating partner being Concern Worldwide Kenya. Funded under the Sustainable Management and Access to Water and Sanitation in the ASALs Programme (SWASAP), the two integrated projects reflect WaterFund's core mandate of investing in underserved and climate-vulnerable areas. North Horr Integrated Project was implemented at a cost of KSh. 33.9 million, while Moyale Integrated Project received KSh. 42.3 million.

North Horr Integrated Project significantly improved water access and sanitation for over 890 households through key investments including the rehabilitation of Tiniku water supply, construction of a 30,000m³ water pan, elevation of a 100m³ steel tank, and VIP latrines in schools. The project also supported CLTS in 32 villages and tree nursery establishment, promoting environmental conservation. Moyale Integrated Project enhanced sanitation for 890 households in 30 villages, provided safe water for over 1,500 households through pipeline extensions, rehabilitated water infrastructure, and installed solar-powered systems. Schools in Sololo and Dabel also benefited from improved sanitation facilities.

Speaking during the event, H.E. Mohamud Ali, Governor Marsabit County and H.E. Solomon Gubo Deputy Governor, Marsabit County lauded the collaboration, reaffirming the County's dedication to equitable access to water and sanitation. Hon. Chepkitony highlighted WaterFund's unwavering mission to serve marginalized communities, and announced ongoing initiatives through the Horn of Africa Programme to continue delivering lasting impact in the region. These integrated projects underscore a shared commitment to sustainable development, improving health outcomes, and securing water resources for future generations in Marsabit County.
